Population, Religions and Languages

- ❑ Taiwan ended 2014 with a population of 23,434,000 people, over 95% of the population is Han Chinese.
- ❑ The five largest religion are: Buddhism (8,086,000 or 35.1%), Taoism (7,600,000 or 33%), Yiguandao (810,000 or 3.5%), Protestantism (605,000 or 2.6%), and Roman Catholicism (298,000 or 1.3%).
- ❑ Mandarin is the official national language.
- ❑ The 70% of the population belonging to the Hoklo ethnic group speak Taiwanese Hokkien (a variant of the Min Nan speech of Fujian province).

Did you know!

- ❑ Number 4 = unlucky, death.
- ❑ Number 8 = prosperity, good luck.
- ❑ In hospitals and most of hotels, their don't 4 floor.
- ❑ Don't giving **clocks!**, avoid giving umbrella's and handkerchiefs and all white flowers. There is too much negative symbolism connected with these gifts.

Place them on the table or in a special bowl for that purpose!

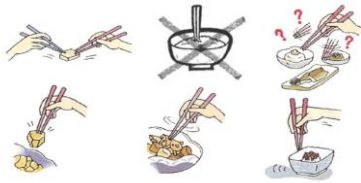
- ❑ Never use your index finger to beckon anyone.

- ❑ Avoid giving anything **made in China!**

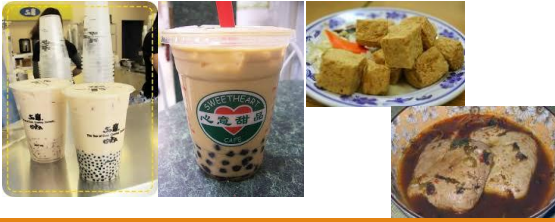

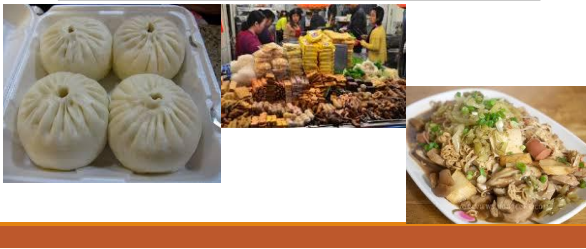
